He has performed with Rickles and major symphony orchestras around the globe. DeSare has three jazz albums under his belt and has been featured on the CBS Early Show, NPR, A Prairie Home Companion, and the Today Show.

Notwithstanding his critically acclaimed work as a singer/pianist, DeSare is also an award-winning composer. He has placed in the USA Songwriting Competition and has written the theme

song for the motion picture, My Date With Dr. Death. He has performed on broadcast commercials and has composed soundtracks for the Hallmark Channel's Santa and Lifetime's Nanette.
