

Boyd Meets Girl

Guitar and cello duo

Preliminary Technical Rider

1. **ARRIVAL:** The duo plan to arrive at your venue 3 hours before the performance is to begin. Thanks for being well prepared to help them present the best possible concert for your audience.
2. **STAGE:** The minimum stage size is 20' wide x 20' deep. The performing area should be free of sets, props and equipment, and be swept clean.
3. **CHAIRS/PIANO BENCHES:** 2 armless/straight-backed chairs place center stage. If available, one or two adjustable piano benches are preferable.
4. **SMALL TABLE:** One small table place between the chairs/benches.
5. **SOUND:** The duo will use the house sound system. They will need one microphone--preferably cordless---to speak with the audience. This mic is to be placed on the table.
6. **HOUSE SOUND ENGINEER:** Please have the house sound engineer available to set and run sound for the performance.
7. **LIGHTING:** The best available lighting will be used. There must be a warm wash over the performers. Specials on the musicians will enhance the audience's enjoyment of their performance. Lights can be set upon arrival.
8. **HOUSE LIGHTING ENGINEER:** Please have the house lighting engineer available at arrival to set and run lights for the duo's performance.
9. **DRESSING ROOM:** One clean, well heated dressing room is needed. It should be equipped with 2 chairs, mirror, clothes rack and waste basket. It should be near private lavatory facilities and the stage.
10. **HOSPITALITY:** 2 bottles of still water and 2 bottles of sparkling water, coffee service and hot tea service (English breakfast tea or similar).
11. **MEAL FOR TWO:** A healthy meal for two must be available two hours before the performance begins. The meals needs to be gluten-free and vegetarian. Suggestions could include fresh fruit, sliced cheeses, gluten-free crackers, and nuts.
12. **CD SALES:** One table in the lobby from which to sell CDs, and one volunteer to assist.
