PRELIMINARY TECHNICAL RIDER

1. **ARRIVAL:** Jason Coleman will plan to arrive 3 hours before the concert is to begin. Thanks for being well prepared to welcome him.
2. **STAGE:** The minimum stage size is 15' wide x 15' deep. The performing area should be free of all sets, props and equipment, and be swept clean.
3. **SCREEN/SCRIM/PROJECTOR:** Jason Coleman has videos to project from a computer. A large screen or scrim behind the piano, if available, is preferred. If a house projector is available, that will work best, but he will carry a small projector if needed. The videos will enhance the audience's enjoyment of her performance.
4. **PIANO:** The best available grand piano is required, including a piano bench. The piano should be moved to center stage on the day of the performance and then tuned to A-440.
5. **SOUND:** Jason Coleman will use the house sound system.
 - a. One Vocal Mic, on a boom stand
 - b. Piano mics (ideally, two condenser mics, one for high and one for low, but one mic can suffice.)
 - c. Two XLR lines, one for backup tracks from Jason's iPad and one for video sound from Jason's computer.
 - d. Floor monitor wedge.
6. **HOUSE SOUND TECHNICIAN:** Please have the house sound technician available to setup and run sound for his performance.
7. **LIGHTING:** The best available lighting will be used. At a minimum, there must be a warm wash over the piano and Jason Coleman. If colored gels or specials are available, they can be set at his arrival, enhancing the audience's enjoyment.
8. **DRESSING ROOM:** One clean, well-heated/cooled dressing room is needed. It should be equipped with chair, mirror, clothes rack and waste basket. It should be near private lavatory facilities and the stage.
9. **HOSPITALITY:** 2 bottles of water, a few granola bars, fresh fruits & veggies upon arrival. Hot meal for 3, 2 hours before the performance. Consult with the artist a few days in advance.
10. **CD SALES:** One table in the lobby to sell CDs and one volunteer to assist.
