ASIYA Korepanova is a pianistic powerhouse who is also a composer, visual artist and poet. Born in Izhevsk, Russia, she began learning the piano at age 4 and made her orchestral debut, playing Mozart's Concerto No. 8, at age 9. Asiya moved to the United States in 2012 to earn a doctoral degree from the University of Miami. Asiya has garnered attention with performances at Carnegie Hall, many notable series, symphony orchestras, and festivals.
