Ticket Information: We only sell our concert tickets as a membership subscription series. We do not sell single-event tickets. In order to succeed financially, and survive as a non-profit volunteer organization, we must sell our season tickets as a subscription package. During our long and successful 90+ year history—we have only sold tickets as a subscription series.

Current members must renew their tickets by March 1, 2022. Starting March 1, all ticket sales will be processed in the order they are received and price goes up to \$55. Waiting list will begin to be processed if tickets are still available. Our **Family** season ticket entitles 2 Adults and all children 18 years old or younger from the same household to attend the concert series. We have priced the family season ticket at a very affordable cost. We believe that it is very important for children to experience the magic of live performances and enjoy quality family entertainment. In addition, the **Student** season ticket entitles children or adolescents 18 years old or younger to attend the concert series. Open Seating—members will be able to sit anywhere they choose in the theater except the (32) box seats which are reserved for our generous sponsors who have donated \$500 or more.
